Subject: Suspension of Walk-in Services at the Downtown Development Services Center

Starting on Monday, Aug. 9, all walk-in services without a previously scheduled appointment at the Downtown Development Services Center in the City Operations Building (COB) are suspended until further notice.

Suspended Walk-in Services

- Walk-in cashier services on the third floor are suspended. However, customers can continue drop-off payments in the first-floor dropbox during normal business hours or <u>pay</u> <u>invoices and fees online</u> 24/7.
- Walk-in services without an appointment for records review are suspended. Customers with an appointment can still view archived building plans or records in person. <u>Schedule</u> <u>your Records Review appointment</u>.

Stairway and Elevator Use for Employees Only

Public use of the stairways and elevators at COB is suspended. The first-floor entrance on First Avenue will be open during business hours to drop off documents and payments. Access to the elevators and stairways will be limited to employee use only.

Entry Procedures: Customers with Appointments Only

Customers without appointments will not be permitted into the building. Customers with <u>appointments</u> can enter the Development Services Center at the <u>City Operations Building</u> using the third-floor bridge connected to the <u>Evan V. Jones Parkade</u> Terrace Level.

No Mask, No Service.

When inside the building, customers must wear a mask or a face covering over their nose and mouth and maintain required social distancing at all times indoors. Customers without a mask or face covering will not be allowed into the building.

Permitted Face Coverings

Permitted face coverings include surgical masks, medical procedure masks, respirators or a tightly woven fabric or non-woven material mask of at least two layers. Face coverings must not contain any visible holes, openings, exhalation valves or vents.

Unpermitted Face Coverings

Face coverings not allowed include scarves, ski masks, gaiters, balaclavas, bandanas, turtleneck collars or other coverings with only a single layer of fabric.
