Subject: Annual Street Work Holiday Construction Restrictions

To support the recovery of local businesses devastated by the economic impacts from COVID-19, reduce traffic congestion and maintain public parking, construction work on City of San Diego public streets in the downtown area and all other streets adjacent to major retail shopping areas will be restricted during the upcoming peak "holiday" shopping season. The holiday season starts Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, Nov. 25, 2021, through New Year's Day, on Saturday, Jan. 1, 2022.

The restrictions intend to avoid impacts to ongoing permitted construction work but limit new construction activities in the right of way. These include:

- Mobilizing and staging heavy equipment, tow cranes and trucks.
- Street, sidewalk and walkway work.
- Trenchwork and dumpster placement, among other activities.

Restricted Construction Activities

Restrictions apply to construction activities that adversely impact the right of way, street parking, vehicle and bicycle travel lanes, or pedestrian sidewalk areas within the areas identified below should be scheduled before or after the holiday season. All other construction work outside of the locations outlined below can continue as permitted.

Areas with Holiday Season Construction Restrictions

The downtown area is bounded by Cedar Street on the north, 12th Avenue on the east, Harbor Drive on the south and North Harbor Drive on the west. Please see the map on page 3 showing the downtown restriction area.

The construction restriction also applies to streets around Fashion Valley Center, Mission Valley Center, University Town Centre, downtown La Jolla and other prominent community retail shopping areas throughout the city.
