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In accordance with Public Utilities Code section 132354.7 and Public Contract Code sections 2600-2602, __Flatiron West, Inc.__(the "Prime Contractor") certifies that all the workers performing work in an apprenticeable occupation utilized on the project known as __Morena Pump Station__ (the "Project") during the monthly reporting period are either skilled journeypersons or apprentices in an apprenticeship program approved by the Chief of the Division of Apprenticeship Standards of the California Department of Industrial Relations (the "Chief").

"Skilled Journeyperson" means a worker who either:

- (1) Graduated from an apprenticeship program for the applicable occupation that was approved by the Chief or apprenticeship program located outside California and approved for federal purposes, pursuant to the apprenticeship regulations adopted by the Federal Secretary of Labor.
- (2) Has at least as many hours of on-the-job experience in the applicable occupation as would be required to graduate from an apprenticeship program that is approved by the Chief.

In addition, the Prime Contractor certifies that it has met the requirements of Public Contract Code 2601(d), subject to certain exceptions set forth therein, that the required percentage of the skilled journeypersons or skilled journeyperson hours employed to perform work on the Project by the Prime Contractor and all subcontractors are graduates of an apprenticeship program for the applicable apprenticeable occupation.

A graduate of an apprenticeship program means either of the following:

- (1) An individual that has been issued a certificate of completion under the authority of the California Apprenticeship Council for completing and apprenticeship program approved by the Chief pursuant to Section 3075 of the Labor Code, or
- (2) An individual that has completed an apprenticeship program located outside California and approved for federal purposes pursuant to the apprenticeship regulations adopted by the federal Secretary of Labor.

To whom it may concern:

GGG Demolition, Inc's findings regarding the Skilled and Trained Workforce:

- The goal for Laborers is 60%. For the month of August, GGG Demolition achieved 50%
- GGG Demolition requested Laborer apprentice graduates. The union sent two skilled and trained laborers and one apprentice (that doesn't count for skilled & trained). The dispatch request specificed "skilled and trained" which unfortunately we thought would suffice, but didn't realize that we should have only requested trained, as that counts toward the 60% trained requirement.
 - Cristian Payo is a 1st period apprentice that was sent out to the project from Local 89, as we thought it would count toward the headcount on skilled & trained, we were incorrect. Should we have been able to use him for the month of August GGG would be at 60%.
- The goal for Operator Engineers is 30%. For the month of August, GGG Demolition achieved 0%
- GGG Demolition did not request a trained Operator as we thought our current Operator would suffice the skilled & trained requirements. We now understand that Mr. Groves only qualifies as skilled.

GGG Demolition, Inc's Plan to achieve the required goal going forward:

• GGG Demolition will start to run numbers weekly or bi-weekly to ensure we are on track with hitting our target goal for the end of the month.

- GGG Demolition has already enrolled 5 Laborers into an accelerated program to help meet the 60% apprentice graduate requirement. The prgram is 6 months long and requires the employee to take an OSHA 30 training and CPR training.
 - Julian Reyes, Antonio Alvarez and Fernando Torres are scheduled to take the OSHA 30/CPR Training the week of 10/18-10/22
 - Rosalino Rojas and Fernando Torres are scheduled to take the OSHA 30/CPR Training the week of 11/8-11/12
- GGG Demolition will be enrolling some of our Operators into an accelerated program to meet
 the 30% apprentice graduate requirement. The program is 6 months long and must have at
 least 6,000 hours; 2.5 years with the Union; must pass a substance abuse test at the end of the 5
 months; must complete sexual harassment prevention training; complete Related and
 Supplemental Instruction Course of at least 72 hours.
