Suspicious Death in Egger Highlands Neighborhood

San Diego – This morning, just after 10:15 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting an unresponsive female had been found in a vehicle at 1600 Bubbling Well Drive in Egger Highlands.

Officers from Southern Division arrived at the location and confirmed the female was obviously deceased in the rear seat of a vehicle parked on the street. The vehicle was registered to the address where it was parked. Officers attempted to speak to a male inside the residence, but he retreated into the home and barricaded himself inside. Officers contained the residence and attempted to negotiate with the male, but he refused to come out. Officers eventually entered the residence and detained the male without further incident.

Due to the suspicious nature of the woman's death, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances surrounding the female's death.

The female has been identified, however her name will not be released at this time. She is described as the 68-year-old Asian female resident of the home where she was found. There were no obvious signs of trauma to her body. The exact cause of her death is pending examination by the San Diego County Medical Examiner.

The detained male is the 37-year-old son of the deceased female. He also lives at the address and is being interviewed by detectives.
