Victim identified in Homicide in Kearny Mesa

San Diego – On Sunday, June 19, 2022, at 12:22 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call of a male that had been stabbed in a parking lot in the 4400 block of Convoy Street. Officers from Eastern Division responded to the location and found a male suffering from multiple stab wounds to his upper body. Officers called for medics and performed life saving measures until paramedics arrived. The male was transported to a nearby hospital where, unfortunately, he was pronounced deceased at 1:10 a.m.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is very early in the investigation and detectives are working to determine the circumstances surrounding the stabbing death of the male but it has been determined the suspect and victim were part of the same group of people that were attending a gathering at restaurant/bar at the location. While there, an altercation occurred between the suspect and victim in the parking lot in which the victim was stabbed and ultimately died from his injuries. The suspect is not in custody and is described as a black male, possibly in his 30's.

The deceased male has been identified as Edward Manier. He is described as a 60-year-old Black male and is a resident of San Diego.
