## Police Investigate Homicide of 14-Year-Old Juvenile in Corridor Neighborhood

**San Diego** – On July 10, 2022, at approximately 1:30 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call of a shooting at Polk Avenue and 37<sup>th</sup> Street in the Corridor neighborhood.

Officers from Mid-City Division arrived at the location and discovered a male teenager down on a sidewalk. He appeared to have suffered at least one gunshot wound. Officers and paramedics began rendering life saving measures. Unfortunately, he was pronounced deceased at the scene. He is described as a 14-year-old Hispanic juvenile. His has been identified, however his name will not be released at this time.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and began investigating the incident. Preliminary information indicated that the victim was walking on foot in the area when he was approached by a group of Hispanic males who shot him. The males possibly left southbound on 37<sup>th</sup> Street in a light-colored sedan. There is no further information about the suspects to be released at this time.

It is very early in the investigation and detectives are still working to determine the circumstances surrounding the shooting, including the motivation and whether there was any sort of interaction between the victim and the suspects. Detectives are gathering and reviewing evidence and interviewing any potential witnesses.
