Police Investigate Homicide in Linda Vista Neighborhood

San Diego — On Sunday, July 24, 2022, just after 5 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting a male down in the 2200 block of Ulric Street in Linda Vista. Officers from Western Division arrived at the location and found an unresponsive male with a gunshot wound to his upper back. The male was being tended to by a family member when officers arrived. Officers immediately began performing life saving measures until San Diego Fire–Rescue personnel arrived and relieved them. Unfortunately, the male was pronounced deceased at the scene at 05:25 a.m.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is still early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the male's death other than it appears the male was walking in the area of 2200 Ulric Street when he was shot by an unknown suspect(s) at some point in the early morning hours before he was found. There is no suspect description at this time. Detectives are in the process of gathering potential evidence and attempting to locate and interview any potential witnesses at this time.

The deceased male has been identified, however his name is not being released at this time pending additional family notifications. He is described as a 41-year-old Hispanic male.
