Victim Identified in Mira Mesa Homicide

San Diego – On October 5, 2022, at approximately 9:30 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call of a shooting in the 10900 block of Deering Street in Mira Mesa.

Officers from Northeastern Division arrived at the location and discovered an 18-year-old Hispanic male down in the street in front of his residence. He had at least one apparent gunshot wound. Officers began rendering life saving measures until paramedics arrived and took over. Unfortunately, the male was pronounced deceased at the scene. He is now identified as Brian Mendoza-Camacho.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate. The investigation is still active and ongoing. Detectives are still attempting to gather information about the circumstances surrounding the shooting, including the motivation and any sort of interaction between the victim and suspect or suspects. Detectives continue to look for evidence and interview any potential witnesses.

There is no information about the suspect or suspects to be released at this time.
