Homicide Investigation on Harbor Drive

San Diego – On Tuesday, November 15th, 2022, at approximately 2:20 p.m., the Port of San Diego Harbor Police Department received a report that two bodies were discovered in a hotel room on the 1900 block of Harbor Drive. Essentially, hotel staff entered the room after the guests failed to check out and discovered the bodies. Harbor Police Officers responded to the call and located a male and female inside a hotel room. Both were obviously deceased with apparent gunshot wounds. A firearm was located inside the hotel room.

The deceased male has been preliminarily identified; however his name is not being released at this time. He is described as an Indian male in his 50's. He is believed to be the registered hotel guest.

The deceased female has not yet been positively identified. She is described as a white female possibly in her 20s or 30s.

San Diego Homicide Detectives responded to investigate. Based on the initial observations of the scene, it appears the most likely scenario is that the male shot the female, and then shot himself.

Detectives are working through the scene to gather evidence and interview witnesses. There is no one else outstanding at this time as no one else appears to have been involved in this incident.
