Victim Identified in Stabbing Death of Male in Barrio Logan

San Diego – On December 11, 2022, at 12:07 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call from a concerned citizen who reported finding a stabbing victim on the sidewalk in the 1600 Block of Logan Avenue in the Barrio Logan neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Central Division were dispatched and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they found a male suffering from multiple stab wounds to his upper body. The officers immediately began first aid efforts and called for medics. However, despite the best efforts of the officers and medical personnel, the male was pronounced deceased at the scene at 12:24 a.m.

Shortly afterwards, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is still early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the male's death. What is known is the victim was with one other male at the time of this incident. That male was briefly detained at the scene but was released a short time later. At this time, detectives are searching the area for any physical evidence, surveillance video or any additional witnesses who may be able to provide more information on the events leading up to the stabbing death of the male.

The deceased male has been identified as Miguel Angel Gonzalez-Valdez of Lemon Grove. He is described as a 31-year-old Hispanic Male. There is no suspect information at this time.
