A graduate of an apprenticeship program means either of the following:

- (1) An individual that has been issued a certificate of completion under the authority of the California Apprenticeship Council for completing and apprenticeship program approved by the Chief pursuant to Section 3075 of the Labor Code, or
- (2) An individual that has completed an apprenticeship program located outside California and approved for federal purposes pursuant to the apprenticeship regulations adopted by the federal Secretary of Labor.

#### Plan to Achieve

WA Rasic has reviewed the March 2022 Skilled and Trained Workforce Monthly Compliance report and has noted that only the WA Rasic Operators Apprentice Graduate % for March 2022 did not attain the required minimum Apprentice Graduate percentages.

At this early stage of the project WA Rasic continues to have a minimal crew on site performing potholing operations. There is currently no need for multiple operators. The 48" Steel Pipe is expected to arrive near the end of April. WA Rasic is currently coordinating with Local Union representatives to identify and hire more Skilled Journeypersons in anticipation of pipeline installation.
