CITY COUNCIL APPROVES FY 2022 BUDGET

SAN DIEGO – On Monday, June 14th the San Diego City Council approved the proposed \$4.6 billion budget. The following is a statement from Council President Campbell on its passage:

“Today we approved the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget. Thank you to the IBA, Mayor Gloria, and each of my Council colleagues for your diligence and thoughtfulness during this year’s unique budget cycle. The approval of this budget shows how united we are in moving San Diego forward.

I also want to thank all the community groups, organizations, and individuals that have remained engaged throughout this process.

We have also dedicated money to supporting small businesses, combating homelessness, tackling climate change and providing the core services San Diegans deserve. Our approved budget includes additional support for the Office of the City Attorney, restoration of funds for Arts & Culture along with funding for tree maintenance, brush, and graffiti abatement, and more.

I am also pleased that the budget includes funding for a second scheduled residential refuse collection in Mission Beach during the summer months. This modest investment is very important for this community and for the environment, especially as our beaches see an increase in visitors and an influx of trash.

Thank you to everyone who helped create an on-time budget that supports workers, families, and businesses throughout our City.”
