Subject: Martin Luther King Jr. Day Office Closure

The Development Services Department (DSD) will be closed for business on Monday, Jan. 16, 2023, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Regular business hours will resume the day after the closure.

During the closure, customers can continue to use online services, including applying for permits, scheduling inspections or requesting code enforcement investigations — among other services — by visiting sandiego.gov/DSD.

Need a Noise Permit?

Applicants must submit a Noise Permit application at least three business days before a holiday closure. As a reminder, an approved [Traffic Control Permit](#) is required prior to applying for a Noise Permit.
