#### **STAFF REPORT**

Suzanne Segur, Senior Planner from the Development Services Department reported that on March 6<sup>th</sup>, the City Council heard the appeal of the Historical designation of the Charles and Mary Schaefer residence and the Fred Bushman building HRB #1412. The Council reversed the designation of the property under Criterion A, which removed the designation from the Charles and Mary Schaefer residence located at 820 W. University Avenue. The Fred Bushman building located at 3951-3957 Goldfinch Street remains designated under Criterion C.

Kelley Stanco, Deputy Director from the Planning Department shared with the Board and the public that they are currently reviewing and working with the State Office of Historic Preservation on the National Register nomination for the La Jolla Park Coastal Historic District. She is looking forward to bringing the item to the Historical Resources Board for a recommendation once it is ready to proceed to the State Historic Resources Commission.
