Subject: Expansion of No-Plan Building Permit Program

To streamline the permitting process and help reduce the cost of plan preparation for applicants, the Development Services Department (DSD) expanded the No-Plan Building Permit program for applications submitted starting today.

A No-Plan Building Permit is an application submitted without a plan, where building code compliance is verified at the time of inspection. Previously, DSD offered No-Plan Building Permits for various projects, as outlined within [Information Bulletin 203](#). In addition to those projects previously allowed to submit as No-Plan Building Permits, DSD will no longer require building construction plans to be submitted for the following project types:

- Multi-Dwelling Unit (MDU) Building Kitchen Remodel.
- MDU Building Bathroom Remodel.
- Door and window replacements on all project types.

Properties with a historic designation or located within a designated historic district must continue to submit plans with their application.
