Subject: Online Permitting Enhancements for Residential Solar Photovoltaic

The Development Services Department (DSD) has scheduled weekend maintenance to enhance the online application process for <u>Residential Solar Photovoltaic (PV) permits</u>. Residential Solar PV permit applications will be unavailable due to system enhancements starting today at 3 p.m. Customers can resume applying for Residential Solar Photovoltaic at 7 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 7.

Upgrading the online permitting system will result in faster and easier application processes for Residential Solar PV permits and battery-storage projects up to 38.4 kW for single-dwelling units and duplexes, ensuring compliance with Senate Bill 379.

The new online features for Building and Land Use enforcement and construction noise applications are among the latest enhancements to the City's permitting process to help reduce permitting processing times and provide enhanced customer service. It is an integral part of #DigitalDSD, an initiative to modernize all DSD workplace systems and cost-effectively leverage technology to increase productivity and improve service delivery.
