SUBJECT: Pedestrian Safety in La Jolla Shores

Following another pedestrian injury accident this past weekend, the La Jolla Shores Association met today, and voted 11-0-0 to request the following safety measures.

I support their requests and respectfully submit them below:

1. Paint or repaint pedestrian crosswalks at all existing traffic signals and all-way stops on La Jolla Shores Drive, Avenida de la Playa, Paseo del Ocaso and El Paseo Grande
2. Install "Pedestrian Crossing/Beach Crossing" warning signs for approaching motorists at all intersections and cross streets on La Jolla Shores Drive between Torrey Pines Road and El Paseo Grande where there is no all-way stop or traffic signal
3. Install a crosswalk with pedestrian activated flashing lights on La Jolla Shores Drive at Vallecitos
