- In honor of National Apprenticeship Week, **SoCal Pre-Apprenticeship** is hosting an apprenticeship fair at the Southeastern LiveWell Center on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, from 10am to 2pm.
- **The Good Neighbor Project (GNP)** announced that they will be in the San Diego Parade of Lights in December. For the first time, Cesar Chavez Park will be used as the judging booth for the Parade. GNP also announced that they would like to have their program operating again. All-Partner Data Review

- The group reviewed the following questions regarding collective impact:
 - How can we work together to better understand the problem?
 - \circ What actions should the PZ and partners focus on before our designation ends?
 - How can we communicate with the greater SD area about the work in the PZ?
 - Do you have projects that you need support in or want to support?
 - What should the PZ look like after 2026?
 - What partnerships do we need to establish before 2026?
 - How can we maximize our partnerships to ensure continued connections after the designation?
- The questions were originally presented at the Promise Zone's All-Partner Meeting on October 4. Partners worked together in small groups to identify answers to these questions.

Jobs and Education Data Review

Amber Weber, San Diego Promise Zone

- The group reviewed data from 2023 related to Jobs and Education in the promise.
- In subgroups, partners discussed what was missing from the data and what tactics we can use to fill the gaps of data.
- The group decided that the data presented needed more context to understand the full scope of what this group should focus on in 2024.
- The San Deigo Promise Zone will work with the Economic Development Department's Economic Research Specialist, to gather relevant data.

Jobs and Education Tactical Ideation

Amber Weber, San Diego Promise Zone

- After reviewing the data, the group decided to focus on 3 tactics:
 - **Asset mapping**: Collaborate with organizations who are doing the same or similar work to share resources and strategies. (e.g., gathering links for a resource page, creating a handout)
 - The group agreed that they want the County of San Diego's Workforce Development Center to be involved in this group.



- **Prepare youth for any career**: Help youth develop soft and transferable skills that are applicable to any career. Come up with innovative ways to help them develop skills. (e.g., financial literacy, resume building)
- **Career exploration**: Expose youth to all career paths (not just trades) and help them understand which careers to explore through surveys and personality tests.
- In our next meeting, the group will participate in a SMART activity to identify specific steps within each tactic and set metrics/outcomes for completion.

Signature Event Planning

Ernesto Rivera, SDCOE

- The group began planning its signature event which will happen sometime in March of 2024. Partners decided to use the same theme, name and branding of the "Your, Future Now: A Youth-Led Career Expo."
 - Since the event was a huge success in 2023, everyone agreed keeping the event the same would build momentum for next year.
- After the meeting, all Job and Education partners received a link to a When2Meet form to finalize the date of the event.
