

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:
Pipeline Work to Begin on Genesee Avenue from Governor Drive towards Centurion Square
for the Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels Project**

Nov. 8, 2023

Construction of the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project in University City is continuing along Genesee Avenue heading north from Governor Drive.

This new section of pipeline construction will include traffic control setup and pipeline construction in Genesee Ave. between Governor Dr. and Luigi Court. Working hours for this segment of pipeline installation will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Work will start in November and continue through Spring 2024. Two-way traffic will be maintained, and there will be no intersection closures as part of this work.

Construction teams will be installing one 48-inch wastewater pipeline and one 30-inch brine pipeline in a 16 foot-wide trench through in the Southbound lanes of Genesee Ave. with traffic being shifted into the North bound lanes around the construction zone to maintain two-way traffic on Genesee Avenue all times. Please plan extra time when traveling on Genesee Avenue. University City High School students and parents are to use the entrance at Centurion Square during the morning school commute/drop off. The student entry will be closed in the morning and the gate will reopen in the afternoon for school dismissal/exit.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as efficiently as possible with safety as our highest priority, and the community's patience and coordination are appreciated.

What to Expect:

- Two-way traffic on Genesee Avenue will remain open.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signage. Please anticipate traffic delays, construction noise and overnight construction lights.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water San Diego Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
