- 2. **Approval of the Minutes:** The draft minutes of the August 9th OMNCPG meeting were approved with a 8-0-1 vote.
- 3. Non-Agenda Public Comments: (2-minute limit per speaker).
 - a. Steve Egger asked for the COW training email to be sent out again. Additionally brought up the Otay River Estuary Restoration Project that will be moving approximately 8,000 truck loads each year for 3 years from Pond 20 Otay River Floodplain site to the Pond 15 site. Fish and Wildlife cleaning up and opening road for emergency access.
 - b. Albert Estrada brought up the SDGE project.
 - c. Brian McGonagill brought up vector control complaints and asked the council district office to address.

- a. Undergrounding of Utilities in Egger Highlands.
 - i. Council voted to set up public hearing to bring back undergrounding. It was halted due to lawsuit over greenhouse gasses being produced.
 - ii. On Oct 17th, second meeting will be held for public hearing and vote on undergrounding.
- b. Tijuana River

- i. USIBWC has created a recovery plan of \$8 million.
 - 1. Priority replacing the pumps at the Hollister station.
 - 2. Will provide updates via X (formerly Twitter).
- ii. Goal is for plant to fully treat 25 million gallons a day of wastewater and meet discharge quality permit parameters. Timeline is 9 months to a year, but incremental progress may be made earlier.
- iii. In parallel, recovery work from Hillary may be completed within 30-90 days.

- d. Robert Egger Park awaiting bidding and contract. Construction expected late fall.
