

## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Pure Water San Diego Subaqueous Pipeline Construction Ongoing at Miramar Reservoir

Nov. 30, 2023

The next phase of construction on the City of San Diego's Pure Water Subaqueous Pipeline project at Miramar Reservoir began this week with the start of pipeline installation.

**What To Expect:** The Subaqueous Pipeline is a one-mile, branched water pipeline at Miramar Reservoir that will include pipeline installation on the lakebed. Construction of the Subaqueous Pipeline on the reservoir began this week. Work barges, which will serve as the on-water platforms from which the contractor will work, and associated equipment to install the pipeline, are now in place.



**Shore areas, including picnic and BBQ areas, paths and shore fishing, are accessible. For safety, public activities on the water are prohibited during construction, including:**

- No boats
- No canoes
- No kayaks
- No float tubes

The project team will work to minimize impacts to the community associated with traffic, construction noise and large construction equipment, but please plan extra time for parking when visiting the reservoir, and please be careful around work zones and heavy equipment. In preparation for pipeline construction, parking stalls were added to offset the portion of the parking lot needed for construction.

**When:** Construction is scheduled from Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Public activities on the water continue to be prohibited since the start of construction in September 2023, for up to one year.

**Why:** This project is part of Pure Water San Diego, the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.
