Subject: DSD Online Services Upgrade for Discretionary PTS Permit Applications

On Monday, Oct. 30, 2023, the Development Services Department (DSD) will convert all active Project Tracking System (PTS) "hybrid" <u>Discretionary Permit</u> applications to a fully cloud-based, online permitting system. The digital conversion replaces the interim "hybrid submittal process" implemented between May 2020 and Dec. 2021 to maintain permitting services during the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic.

System Upgrade Timeline

- Oct. 26 All <u>OpenDSD</u> Hybrid PTS Projects Currently in Review Will be Closed To accommodate the online services upgrade, on Thursday, Oct. 26 at 4 p.m., all active discretionary PTS permit applications using the hybrid submittal process will be closed and converted to PRJ permit applications using the <u>DSD Online Services</u> customer portal.
- Oct. 30 Go Live with the Upgrade from Hybrid PTS to Full PRJ Projects
 DSD will resume processing all discretionary PTS permit applications and resubmittals that
 have been converted to the online permit system on Monday, Oct. 30, at 7 a.m. Customers
 will be able to access project status, project issues reports, documents and invoicing
 through DSD's Online Services portal.

#DigitalDSD The upgrade of PTS "hybrid" Discretionary Permit applications is among the latest enhancements to the City's permitting process to help reduce permitting processing times and provide enhanced service to customers. It is an integral part of #DigitalDSD, an initiative to modernize all DSD workplace systems and cost-effectively leverage technology to increase productivity and improve service delivery.
