#### 101. Movies in the Park:

#### 102. Cookies with Santa

Mr. Herrera mentioned that the Cookies with Santa event is scheduled for December  $9^{th}$ , 2023, from 10am – 12pm. We are planning to bring back the cookie decorating depending on any covid restrictions. There will be an obstacle course jumper, cookies, crafts, possible carnival games.

# 103. Canon Pocket Park- Update:

Ms. Anderson reported that it has been just about a month since the groundbreaking. The contractor is focusing on leveling the ground and carving in the ground, so the park is at a flat plateau. The surveyors have been out to determine what the park boundaries will be as well as the city lines. Mr. Klees and Ms. Diedrick voiced their concerns regarding the overgrown trees encroaching over their property's fence lines as well as the exposed cement pole base. Mr. Sevrens asked about the paper street that has not been addressed that is at the base of the slope. Ms. Anderson mentioned that city staff will not be able to access the area until the construction is complete. Mr. Herrera will cut as much of the overgrown trees encroaching the fence line as possible. Mr. Harder asked if there will be an additional survey done in addition to the 3 that have been completed.

## 104. FY25 Budget Input Session

Mr. Herrera mentioned that Dance to Evolve will be returning as contractor. Staff run programs planned are Soccer 101, Winter/Summer camps, Walking Club, Adult Tea Social and Crafts. Mr. Klees suggested reaching out to Eleanor to help publicize. 3 Movies in the park will be in the budget, as well as Spring Fling and Cookies with Santa for FY 25.
