

The Chollas Creek Master Plan will be a long-term planning document developed by the City in partnership with stakeholders and community members to guide the sustainable future of Chollas Creek Watershed as a regional park.






- The watershed planning area stretches across the neighborhoods of City Heights, Eastern Area, Encanto, Southeastern San Diego, Barrio Logan, Greater Golden Hill, North Park and Normal Heights.
- The watershed is a vital natural resource that plays a crucial role in preserving the region's ecological benefits as well as providing opportunities for community-serving recreation.



- Incorporating the community's vision, it serves as a guide for informing future improvements, amenities, expansions, and park programming.



WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE MASTER PLAN?

- Once adopted by City Council, the Chollas Creek Master Plan will:
 - Identify goals, standards, and policies to guide future capital improvement projects in the regional park.
 - Study park typologies and identify potentially suitable sites.
 - Outline a phased implementation strategy to identify which areas should be prioritized for future funding.
 - Highlight neighborhoods within the regional park with the greatest need for resources.




Project Website


SITE WALK AUDIT

 - Chollas Creek Canyon (Oak Park Trail)




SITE WALK AT SOUTHCREST TRAILS PARK



PUBLIC SURVEY

October 2023 to Spring 2024

- bit.ly/ChollasCreekSurvey
- ~ 5-min. digital survey for participants to share their preferences, needs and ideas for the watershed and master plan.
- Distributed through City social media platforms, newsletters and Groundwork mobile engagement events.
- Received 50+ responses so far.

- The 1st workshop series will be held on 11/17 & 11/18.




