Police Arrest Suspect Who Threatened School Shooting; Seek Additional Information from the Public

San Diego – On December 1st, 2023, the San Diego Police Department arrested 38-year-old Lee Lor for threatening to commit a mass shooting at Shoal Creek Elementary School. After the threat was communicated to a third party, SDPD Northeastern Division investigators acted quickly to locate and arrest Mr. Lor for making criminal threats.

Mr. Lor was arraigned today in San Diego Superior Court on one felony count of making criminal threats. A Gun Violence Restraining Order was granted by the court prohibiting Lor from possessing or purchasing any firearms. The judge issued a no-bail hold on Lor and a criminal protective order was issued to protect Shoal Creek Elementary School.
