NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - Harney Street Market 2024

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Old Town

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

LOCATION: Harney Street, between San Diego Avenue and Congress Street

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a weekly (Saturday and Sunday), year-round artisans' market that would include merchandise vendors, food booths, onsite food preparation, canopies, that would occur on Harney Street between San Diego Avenue and Congress Street every Saturday and Sunday from January 6, 2024, through December 29, 2024, every Saturday and Sunday 10 AM to 4 PM in off-peak season; every Saturday 10 AM to 5:30 PM and Sunday 10 AM to 4:30 PM in peak season. See attachment with dates and times. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 6 AM until 7 PM.

For Saturday and Sunday off-peak hours:

Set-up would occur from 6 AM until 9 AM, the market would be open from 10 AM to 4 PM, and dismantling would occur from 4 PM to 6:30 PM.

For Saturday peak hours:

Set-up would occur from 6 AM until 9 AM, the market would be open from 10 AM to 5:30 PM, and dismantling would occur from 5:30 PM to 7 PM.

For Sunday peak hours:

Set-up would occur from 6 AM until 9 AM, the market would be open from 10 AM to 4:30 PM, and dismantling would occur from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM.

A road closure would occur with this event on Harney Street between San Diego Avenue and Congress Street from 6 AM until 6:30 PM for Saturday/Sunday Off-Peak dates and on Sunday Peak hours; from 6 AM until 7 PM on Saturday Peak hours. See attachments for dates.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
