HOMELESSNESS STRATEGIES & SOLUTIONS



The City of San Diego recently opened its second of two Safe Sleeping sites. This one is at the O Lot on the edge of Balboa Park. My staff and I recently had an opportunity to see first-hand how the sites work. The program provides solutions to people experiencing homelessness. Parking Lot O has on-site meals, restrooms, showers, laundry, 24-hour security, storage, resource referrals, and housing navigation. ELECTRONIC RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL

EnviroGreen Electronic Recycling Services is partnering with Pechanga Arena to host a drive-through electronic recycling and disposal event on Wednesday, November 15, 2023. All electronic items – anything with a plug or a battery – may be dropped off at the drive-through distribution event. Most electronic items will be accepted at no cost, allowing participants to avoid paying landfill fees and adding to landfill levels. However, fees may apply to a collection of some items, such as:

Refrigerators

• Secure paper shredding will be available for \$5 per "banker's box"

• Secure destruction of hard drives will be available for \$10 per drive. The event will be held at Pechanga Arena, 3500 Sports Arena Boulevard, from 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The event is open to the public.

SD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION



The San Diego International Airport's Terminal 1 has been undergoing extensive construction to introduce a modern and highly efficient facility. A new entrance road and pedestrian walkway were inaugurated on westbound N. Harbor Drive, making a pivotal shift in travel convenience. As construction continues, there are upcoming airport closures:

Closure of Terminal 1 entrance to Harbor Island Drive from October 28 to November 13, 2023.

• Reopening of N. Harbor Drive entrance at the junction of N. Harbor Drive and Harbor Island Drive will resume operations on November 14, 2023. This marks the restoration of access to Terminal 1 through the original entry point.

• The New Pedestrian Pathway will start near the intersection of Harbor Island Drive and N. Harbor Drive. This walkway is designed to facilitate an efficient pedestrian flow to Terminal 1.

These changes are a step toward a more modern and efficient travel experience at the San Diego International Airport at Terminal 1.
