CITY COUNCIL

Lizzie Rodriguez reported the following:

- Reported that Memorial Recreation Center will have a Harvest Festival Friday November 17th, 2023 from 5:30-8:30pm
- On November 18th, 2023 The San Diego Police Department is hosting SDPD Protecting Lives, where community members could learn what they police do and how they do and what they do in their job.
- Logan Heights CDC presents Light Up Logan on December 1st, 2023 from 4-8pm
- Sherman Heights Community Center is having their 3rd Annual Snowy Wonderland Family Event on December 3rd, 2023 from 12-4pm
- Boston Ave Community is having improvements on the pedestrian bridge where they will remove the staircase and build a new ramp for a better access for people who travel by bike or wheelchair
- The Transportation Department sends a tentative streetlight maintenance/repair workplan sheet every month where it says in what District and Area, they will start fixing lights. Moving forward she will be presenting that sheet in all meeting to show people where they are focusing on.
- On the last three days of August she spent 3 and a half hours driving around Sherman Heights, Grant Hill, Barrio Logan, and Logan Heights taking pictures of all streetlights that weren't working, it came out to a little over Eighty-six lights. She still has to come to Shell Town and Southcrest Area to see how many lights aren't working
- They sent the list of lights that aren't working to The Transportation Department and the Mayor sent the list back listing on one side the lights that they have reported and fixed and the other side listing lights they will fix by February.

SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT

Omar Luzuriaga reported the following:

- "Get it Done"- Homelessness and Parking issues go to the Police Department, maintenance concerns go to Council Members Office.
- Police presence is active but limited due to understaffing they will do their best.
- Submitting "Get it Done" creates paper trail of proof for citations.
- "Winter Wonderland" is an event to bring attention to the park, will take place at Southcrest on December 9th, 2023.
- The goal is to keep the park active and unite the community.
- Can be used to then ask for concerns to be resolved.
- Seeking volunteers for "Winter Wonderland event".
- Meetings on Tuesday and Thursday for planning and resources. Meetings take play at 5000 Imperial Ave, everyone is welcome.
- "Be an Officer for a day"- November 18th,2023 to see through the lens of an officer.

- November 18th- Free Turkeys at the Jacobs center, 10am-2pm- First come, First Serve.
- Officer Omar shared about open meeting from Aug/Sep that discussed camera actions and very few San Diego Residents showed up. Only seven people attended.
- Technology is not to invade privacy but to catch criminals, would be based on high crime rates.
- PD website has maps of where cameras will be put.
- License Plates Readers will be enforced in these areas.
- <u>Southeastern Only Crime Stats</u>
 - -This year: 58 shootings, 4 have been homicides
 - -7 shootings in October 2 in November
 - Last year: 77 shootings, 8 homicides
 - -Gun recovery: Last year, 2022: 192 firearm recoveries
 - This year, 2023: 154, 40 from Proactive arrests
