SUBJECT: Annual Evaluation and Report for Fiscal Year 2023 Citywide Grant

Activities

This memorandum contains the Annual Evaluation and Report for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 on City of San Diego grant activities, pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code §22.5205, which states:

Within 90 days of the end of each fiscal year, the City Manager shall provide Council with a written report of all initial grant applications and renewal requests that were accepted, appropriated, and expended by the City Manager during that fiscal year.

Background

The FY 2023 Citywide Grants Report is the City's fifth annual report containing an inventory and analysis of all grant activity from the previous fiscal year. The report serves to provide a comprehensive overview of all citywide grant activity, with the goal of documenting the progress that the City of San Diego has made to improve its internal grant operations and overall performance.

In 2019, the City implemented recommendations from a performance audit of its grant management practices. Since that time, the grants division of the Department of Government Affairs, has built out the citywide grant management function by developing processes to strengthen strategic alignment, provide trainings, facilitate robust internal reviews, share resources and funding opportunities citywide, and improve fiscal accountability.

Government Affairs staff works closely with the City's grant-active departments to ensure that submitted grant applications are reviewed and approved by our Deputy Chief Operating Officers, the Department of Finance, and Chief Operating Officer. Since the division's inception, it has implemented the following process enhancements resulting in year-over-year application and award increases:

- Developed an automated approval system for grant applications, which has enhanced inter-departmental coordination and internal controls;
- Streamlined communication with city staff, funders, and stakeholders regarding federal, state, local, and private funding opportunities;
- Designated primary points of contact among departments to provide technical assistance, training, and partnership opportunities with external regional agencies and community-based organizations; and
- Established a grant working group led by the Government Affairs grants division and attended by designees from grant-active departments as a resource for training, best practices, problem-solving and process improvement.

As the City continues to build on its grants successes, the City Council approved two additional grant coordinator positions in the FY2022 budget to support operational departments in their pursuit of funding opportunities. The positions have recently been filled under the Office of the Chief Operating Officer and have proven to be successful in assisting departments with capacity constraints in identifying funding opportunities, developing and submitting applications, and winning competitive grant awards.

Overview

The annual Citywide Grants Report tracks grant funding pursued by, and awarded to, the City each fiscal year. The City defines grant funding as "monetary funding, equipment, in-kind goods or services, or other assets provided by a granting agency to the City. Grants awarded to the City are funds or products to fund a specific project, activity, or program that requires some level of compliance and reporting."

The FY 2023 report illustrates a continued upward trend in both the number and value of the City's submitted grant applications and awards. It is important to note that many awards contained in this report were applied for in or before FY 2022, and we include multi-year grant disbursements every year until the end of their grant terms.

FY 2023 was the second year in a row to include a significant increase in Federal and State special community project allocations, which were successfully secured through the Department of Government Affairs' advocacy. These allocations are called out as Federal Member Directed Spending and State General Fund Specified Grants at the bottom of Attachments 1 and 2. Additionally, two grants we are including for the first time this year are the City's formula allocations from the State's SB 1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), and the San Diego Association of Governments' (SANDAG) TransNet Local Street Improvement Program. For the annual comparison charts in this report, RMRA and TransNet allocations from FY 2020 through FY 2022 have been added to previous years' reported grant totals to show changes more accurately in grant activity.

In addition to the advocacy work the Department of Government Affairs does for direct grants to the City, the Department also coordinates with regional agencies on federal funding opportunities created under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) and the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA). The \$1.2 trillion IIJA and \$783 billion IRA represent an unprecedented and historical investment in local infrastructure and

climate resiliency through a variety of competitive grant programs for local governments. The City continues to aggressively pursue funding originating from these opportunities, which has resulted in additional applications in this report, and awards that will be reported in future fiscal years.

To ensure that our region is prepared and well-positioned to compete for these dollars, the Department of Government Affairs leads a strategic working group consisting of SANDAG, the Port of San Diego, San Diego International Airport, Caltrans, local utility and transit operators, San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce, and organized labor. This coordinated effort saw over \$248 million dollars in competitive awards to agencies in our region in FY 2022.


Applications

In FY 2023, the City submitted a total of 132 grant applications valued at \$494,139,698, compared with 102 applications valued at \$325,483,538 in FY 2022. This represents a 29% increase in application volume, and 52% increase in total application value.

Awards

In FY 2023, the City received a total of 98 awards valued at \$306,470,386, compared to 63 awards valued at \$295,204,942 in FY 2022. This represents a 54% increase in award volume, and nearly 4% increase in total award value.


Awards by Source

The City's FY 2023 grant awards consisted of 65% state funding, 19% federal funding, and the remaining 16% came from local and private sources. This breakdown was generally comparable to FY 2022.

Awards by Type

57% of the FY 2023 awards were from competitive grant programs, while the remaining 43% were from formula-based (non-competitively awarded) funds. Conversely, the majority of FY 2022's funding was formula-based. This inversion was due primarily to the \$111 million that the City received in Federal and State special community project allocations in FY 2023.

We are committed to continuing our work in support of the legislative priorities set by the Mayor and City Council to compete strategically for grants that fund the needs of our communities, while also supporting our partner agencies on applications with shared regional benefits.
