City of San Diego Hosts Inaugural Torrey Pines Adaptive Golf Championship

TOURNAMENT KICKS OFF TOMORROW, WILL SPOTLIGHT THE TALENTS OF GOLFERS WITH DISABILITIES

SAN DIEGO – Golf is for everyone and to amplify the abilities of a wide range of golfers, the City of San Diego will host the inaugural Torrey Pines Adaptive Golf Championship on Thursday, May 4.

The tournament, which will take place at the nation's foremost municipal golf course, Torrey Pines, is intended to provide a space for golfers with disabilities and other adaptations to compete and showcase their talents. Golf is a fast-growing sport, and the City's Golf Operations Division and Therapeutic Recreation Services want to promote the sport's accessibility for enthusiasts of all abilities.

"All golfers deserve the opportunity to participate in the game and showcase their abilities," said Golf Operations Division Deputy Director Scott Bentley. "We hope this championship highlights Torrey Pines' accessibility for golfers of all abilities and we want all golfers to not only enjoy the course during this tournament, but year-round."

The championship will feature adaptive golfers of all ages and experience levels and will take place on the Torrey Pines North Course, with a Modified Shotgun starting at 7:36 a.m.
