Police Investigate Shooting Death of Male and Two Other Juveniles Injured in Lincoln Park

San Diego – On January 10, 2023, at 2:37 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting a shooting at a residence in the 4700 Block of Nogal Street in the Lincoln Park Neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Southeastern Division were immediately dispatched and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they found three victims suffering from gunshot wounds in the garage of the residence. The first victim was a 20-year-old Black male with multiple gunshot wounds to his chest. The second victim is a 16-year-old Asian female with a gunshot wound to her arm and abdomen. The third victim is a 17-year-old Black male with a gunshot wound to his leg. Responding Officers and Paramedics immediately began providing medical aid to each of the victims. The 16-year-old and 17-year-old were transported by Paramedics to local hospitals for treatment. Their injuries are not considered life threatening. Unfortunately, despite the best efforts of the officers and medical personnel, the 20-year-old male was pronounced deceased at the scene at 03:00 a.m.

It is still early in the investigation and Detectives are working to determine the circumstances surrounding the shooting. At this time information is very limited, but it appears there may be some type of relationship between the suspect and the victim(s) in this incident. However, the exact nature of that relationship has not been determined or confirmed at this time. What is known is a lone male suspect wearing dark clothing was seen running from the location of the shooting. There is no suspect vehicle information at this time. Detectives are currently processing the scene for evidence, canvassing the area for possible surveillance video footage and interviewing witnesses.

The deceased male has been identified but his name is not being released at this time pending family notifications. The two teenaged victims have been identified but their names will not be released.
