SDPD Seeks Public's Help in Sexual Battery Investigation Involving Female Joggers in University Towne Center

San Diego – Detectives from SDPD's Northern Division are investigating a series of four different sexual batteries and one indecent exposure case against female joggers in the University Towne Center neighborhood.

The cases occurred in the following areas between February 7th and February 17th:

8100 Via Kino, 7900 Caminito Dia, Nobel and Regents, 9100 Judicial Drive, and 4000 Palmilla Drive.

The women were exercising in a nearby park. In three of the cases, the suspect followed the women and accosted them just outside their homes. Two of the cases occurred while the women were walking down the street.

Detectives have been collecting evidence, interviewing witnesses, and following leads.

Anyone with information about these cases or who knows an unreported victim is urged to come forward.

The suspect has been described as a Black man, 20-30 years old, 5'8"-6'0", 165-185 pounds with an athletic/muscular build. He was also described as having short dreadlocks and brown eyes.
