Former SDSU Football Player Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

San Diego – A former SDSU football player is in custody on one charge of possession of child pornography. 20-year-old Ewakiko Nowlin was subject of an investigation into a reported gang rape off-campus in the College Neighborhood of San Diego in late 2021.

Sex Crimes Investigators served multiple search warrants during that case and recovered several terabytes of digital evidence. Detectives discovered Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM), commonly known as child pornography, in Nowlin's possession. The case was then turned over to investigators from the San Diego Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC). Police obtained a court-authorized arrest warrant based on their investigation.

Nowlin turned himself into authorities and was booked into San Diego County Jail on one felony charge of possession of child pornography.
