Police Investigate Death of Male in Tierrasanta

San Diego — At approximately 11:27 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call to assist San Diego Fire Personnel on a report of a death at a residence in the 10600 block of Esmeraldas Drive in the Tierrasanta neighborhood of San Diego. San Diego Fire–Rescue personnel had responded to a report from a female that her husband had fallen down the stairs of their residence at that location. Upon arriving, San Diego Fire Rescue personnel immediately rendered first aid, but despite their best efforts, the male was pronounced deceased at 11:40 a.m. Officers from Eastern Division responded and met with Fire Rescue Personnel. Due to unusual circumstances surrounding the death of the male, and in an abundance of caution, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate. At this time, the cause of death for the male is undetermined. Detectives are in the process of interviewing witnesses and gathering any evidence that may assist in further clarifying the circumstances surrounding the death of the male.

The deceased male has been identified, however his name is not being released at this time pending additional family notifications. He is described as a 60-year-old white male. The exact cause of his death is pending examination by the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office.
