Police Investigate Shooting Death of Male in Barrio Logan

San Diego – On June 2, 2023, at 5:49 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received several calls from concerned citizens who reported a shooting in the 1600 block of Logan Avenue in the Barrio Logan neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Central Division were dispatched and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they found a male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to his chest. The officers immediately began first aid efforts and called for medics. However, despite the best efforts of the officers and medical personnel, the male was pronounced deceased at a local hospital at 6:39 a.m.

Shortly afterwards, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is still early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances leading up to the male's death. What is known is the victim got into some type of a verbal confrontation with another male shortly before he was shot. After the victim was shot, several people fled the area on foot, including the suspect. At this time, detectives are searching the area for any physical evidence, surveillance video or any additional witnesses who may be able to provide more information on the events leading up to the shooting death of the male.

The deceased male has been identified. However, his identity is not being released at this time pending notifications of family. The victim is described a 53-year-old Black male. Due to the numerous people that fled the area immediately after the shooting, there is no suspect description at this time.
