Additional Arrests Made in 2022 Lincoln Park Homicide

San Diego – On August 12, 2022, at approximately 9:15 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a report of gunshots heard in the area of 4900 Logan Avenue in the Lincoln Park neighborhood. Officers from Southeastern Division responded to the call. Upon their arrival, they were directed to a male down on the street of an apartment complex. The male had at least one gunshot wound. Officers began lifesaving measures until San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel arrived and transported the male to a local hospital. Unfortunately, he was pronounced deceased at the hospital.

The male was identified as Tre’Von Stewart-Jordan. He is described as a 27-year-old Black male.

San Diego Homicide Detectives responded to investigate the shooting and have been investigating since the time of the murder. Previously, on August 31, 2022, a male named Joseph Nisbet was arrested for this murder. Later, on November 16, 2022, a 17-year-old Black male juvenile was also arrested for this murder.

Detectives have continued to work on this investigation. Based on their efforts, three additional suspects have been identified:

- (1) Tambrisha Jones, described as a 26-year-old Black female
- (2) Haben Haile, described as a 25-year-old Black male
- (3) Richard Bell, described as a 21-year-old Black male

On July 31, 2023, Jones was located and arrested in Glendale, California by the Los Angeles Police Department and U.S. Marshalls. She was booked into jail on murder and conspiracy to commit murder.

Haile and Bell were both in custody on other charges. They were also booked for murder and conspiracy to commit murder. Anyone with information regarding this incident is encouraged to call the Homicide Unit at (619) 531-2293 or Crime Stoppers at (888) 580-8477.

All three are scheduled to be arraigned at the Downtown Courthouse on Thursday, August 3, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.
