Additional Arrest Made in Stabbing Death of Male in Logan Heights

San Diego – On Thursday, August 24, 2023, at 10:32 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call reporting a male had been stabbed at the trolley stop in the Logan Heights neighborhood of San Diego. Officers from Central Division and paramedics from San Diego Fire-Rescue were dispatched and arrived within minutes of the original call. Upon arriving, they found a male suffering from at least one stab wound to his chest. Paramedics transported the male to a local hospital, but despite the best attempts of medical personnel, the male died at the hospital a short time later.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and have spent the past several weeks continuing to investigate this incident. Detectives have learned the victim got involved in a brief verbal argument with a small group of males and a female in the moments before a fight broke out. During this altercation, the victim was stabbed at least one time in the chest and beaten. The suspect group fled the area.

The victim has been identified as Michael Goodin of San Diego. He is described as a 70-year-old Black male.

During the course of this investigation, Detectives identified Angel Salcedo of San Diego as an additional suspect in this case. Salcedo is described as an 18-year-old Hispanic male.

On October 2, 2023, at approximately 1:30 p.m., Salcedo was located at 3600 Main Street by officers from Southeastern Division. He was detained and subsequently arrested per this case. Salcedo was booked into San Diego County Jail for murder and elder abuse.
