**Subject: Annual Beach Area Construction Restriction - 2023**

---

The City of San Diego Annual Beach Area Construction Restriction limits non-emergency construction work during the summer period, minimizing impacts on beach area businesses and tourism. The summer period is considered to extend from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

The restriction affects travel lanes, parking lanes, and pedestrian walkways on significant roadways entering and exiting the beach areas, where merchants and tourism could be adversely affected by construction activities. The periods of most critical concern are Memorial Day (May 29), Independence Day (July 4) and Labor Day (Sept. 4).
