# Goal: Increase access to quality affordable housing

- Objective I: Create and preserve affordable housing
  - Priority: Monitor progress and track data
    - A. Use San Diego Housing Commission data to update information on affordable housing units in the Promise Zone and current developments
- <u>Objective II:</u> Support renters, first-time homebuyers, and people without housing
  - <u>Priority:</u> Promote resources for current and future renters
    - B. In 2023, release a Housing and Homelessness Solutions trifold with resources for community members facing homelessness, partners, and developers
  - <u>Priority:</u> Support renters in the Promise Zone
    - C. Collaborate with Legal Aid Society to create Renters Workshops with data on the needs of renters, information about renters' rights, and how partners can best assist Promise Zone renters
