UPDATE:

Sergeant Elliott Returns to San Diego

San Diego – Making nothing short of an amazing recovery from a serious gunshot injury to his head, Sergeant Anthony Elliott and his family returned to San Diego today and were welcomed by Police Chief David Nisleit and members of the department.

Due to the Dec. 7 incident in 4S Ranch, Sgt. Elliott lost the use of his left arm and leg, and was initially unable to walk. The rehabilitation therapy started just days after the incident and intensified after he was transferred to an out-of-state facility on Dec. 21. Through perseverance, Sgt. Elliott proudly walked through the crowds at the San Diego International Airport to return home.

Sgt. Elliott will continue therapy at an outpatient rehab facility in the San Diego area. He and his family continue to be grateful for the support they receive from the entire San Diego community.
