NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

SPECIAL EVENTS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: Special Event Permit - Screen Your Gut - Save Your Butt 5k Challenge

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Mission Bay Park

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 2

LOCATION: Mission Bay Park/De Anza Cove (2840 N Mission Bay Dr.)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a 5K run/walk and expo event that would include the race routes, music, and the temporary use of a stage, tents/canopies, a generators, tables and chairs, portable restrooms, recycling and trash containers, an inflatable, and sound amplification that would occur in Mission Bay Park and De Anza Cove on March 9, 2024. The expo and registration would take place in the grassy area, and the start and finish line would be located in the parking lot. All activities would be confined to the grass and parking lot. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur from 2 PM on March 8, 2024, until 2:30 PM on March 9, 2024. Set-up would occur from 2 PM until 7:30 PM on March 8, 2024, and from 5 AM until 8 AM on March 9, 2024. On March 9, 2024, the event would occur from 8 AM until 11 AM, and dismantling would occur from 11 AM until 2:30 PM. Sound amplification for the event announcements and music would be from 7 AM until 11:30 AM on event date. The start and finish line would be located in the De Anza Cove parking lot. The route map outlining the 5K run/walk is attached.

A road closure associated with this event would occur on March 9, 2024, and would include N. Mission Bay Drive and E. Mission Bay Drive between the SD Mission Bay Resort De Anza Cove south parking lot to Playa Pacifica parking lot road from 7 AM until 11 AM. This would be a "moving closure" as soon as the last walker is through, it would be re-opened.

The De Anza Cove parking lot would be closed to the public on from 2 PM on March 8, 2024, until 2 PM on March 9, 2024. Parking closures associated with the event would occur on March 9, 2024, from 5 AM until 2 PM and would include both sides of East Mission Bay Dr from 4130 Mission Bay Dr (It is the intersection of Mission Bay Dr & North Mission Bay Dr) to the Hilton Hotel located at 2314 Mission Bay Dr.; both sides of North Mission Bay Dr between Mission Bay Dr & Clairemont Dr.; and both sides of Mission Bay Drive from De Anza Cove parking lot Road to Playa Pacifica Parking Road.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities); Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land); Section 15311

(Accessory Structures).

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal.
2. Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal

and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building— Public Information Counter (Open 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday excluding City approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
