



CITY HEIGHTS AREA PLANNING COMMITTEE 2024 ELECTION

The City Heights Area Planning Committee (CHAPC) will hold its annual election on Monday March 4, 2024. The Planning Committee advises the San Diego City Planning Commission and the City Council on land use decisions in City Heights. This can include many things, from placing a stop sign, to where to locate a new school or a housing development. We are actively seeking to fill eleven positions for two-year terms.

Candidates can qualify by being adult residents of City Heights, youth residents of City Heights, owning a business or rental property in City Heights, or representing a school or non-profit located in and serving the residents of City Heights. All interested candidates **MUST** attend one meeting of the CHAPC in the previous 12 months before an election in order to be certified as eligible to run for election. *The CHAPC meets the first Monday of each month at 6:30pm at 3910 University Avenue, 1st floor lecture hall.* The next meetings before the election deadline will be held on January 8 & February 5, 2024.

Candidates for election are required to fill out an application form (attached), attach a photocopy of your photo identification as well as proof of your home address (such as utility bill or other document with your name and address on it). For business seats or school/non-profit seats, you must include the address of your business, school or non-profit and a letter from the business or school or agency identifying you as a member or employee. Youth Seat candidates must include a permission form signed by your parent or guardian (attached). Candidates may also submit a short biography of no more than 100 words describing their background and reasons for wanting to serve on the committee. These will be posted at the election site. There will be an opportunity to speak during a candidate's forum beginning at 6:00PM on March 4th at the CHAPC meeting location, prior to the CHAPC meeting. Please note that we are seeking candidates of differing economic and ethnic backgrounds so that our committee can adequately represent the diversity within City Heights. Being a member of the Area Planning Committee is an excellent way for you to participate in important decisions that affect the future of our community.
