COMMUNITY MEETING NOTICE: SDPD to Present on 10 Technologies

San Diego – To comply with the City of San Diego's <u>Surveillance Ordinance</u>, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) will hold a community meeting to share information about 10 additional technologies on Thursday, Feb. 1, at 6 p.m.

SDPD uses various technologies to assist in providing public safety services to all San Diego communities. The technologies being presented include:

- 836 Technologies Tactical Throw Phone
- 836 Technologies CINT Commander II
- 3500 Genetic Analyzer
- CODIS Software
- Crosslink
- FLIR FirstLook (Gen 1) Robot
- FLIR FirstLook (Gen 2) Robot
- ICOR Mini-Caliber Robot
- STRmix Software
- SWIFT Under Door Camera

The community meeting to solicit feedback will consist of one location serving as the hub for the main presentation on the technologies, with eight other locations throughout the City simulcasting the presentation and allowing in-person attendance and public comment.

In addition to the in-person, simulcast meeting in all nine City Council Districts, SDPD will post a recording of the presentation to its <u>technology website</u>. Online public comment for the technologies will be accepted until 5 p.m. on Feb. 5. Community members are encouraged to review the Use Policies and supporting materials prior to attending the community meeting.
