DMM Security Subcommittee Report Sellemi/Rabbitt/Guy/Vinson

As follow up Christian Tresize asked about the status of the presentation of the DMMPB findings and reports to Councilmember LaCava, and also reported that he would be happy to represent DMMPB at the upcoming Joint Chairman committee regarding security matters. Tim Guy reported on the break in of the shared mailbox, and as of today no response from the Post Office on corrective action and repairs. Christian Tresize reported that the approach he used to deal with the same matter was initially nice and polite but then had to get much more direct with them. Terri Ann Skelly asked how to know when there has been a break in since she received a notice that there was a break in but not missing anything or seeing any evidence of damage. Chairman Metcalf suggested that it should be pretty obvious such as a crowbar break in. Wendy Poyhonen reported that her mailbox had been broken into when it was not physically obvious. Derek Reeves reported that he received the same notice but knows of no theft. Christian Tresize reminded that there was a set of master keys that were stolen so there would be no evidence of a physical break in. Tim Guy reported that there was a police report filed and there have been dozens of calls to the 877 number provided by Patricia Mendoza the Team Leader for Mail Theft and USPS with zero response. Gonzalo Rocha-Vazquez suggested that concerned residents contact their state representatives. Chairman Metcalf reported that his observation is that taxpayers are not getting what they pay for. Tim Guy expressed appreciation for the support of the Board in dealing with these issues. It was unknown if the notices from the Post Office are going out to everyone or only to compromised mailboxes.

Bob Howards water bill charges from PUD

Chairman Metcalf commented on the city response which is unacceptable and that Bob Howard is rightfully exasperated and has been the only one maintaining the entrance to Del Mar Mesa which is actually the responsibly of the City of San Diego which refuses to acknowledge that they have responsibility for the ROW (right of way). There were several additional comments about the negligence of the city especially with water leaks in the park which create muddy bogs, and have actually tried to charge the Duck Pond HOA for their water lines. Wendy Poyhonen raised the neglect of the park and also the lack of willingness to allow the local HOA's to help in any way. Chairman Metcalf noted that it will be necessary to get the direct involvement of Joe LaCava. Chairman Metcalf spoke about the limitations which also impact property values for DMM. Derek Reeves commented on the fact that the recent letter from the city that the failure to pay the water bill will not result in having the water turned off, and that the reports of so many residents tossing their water bills in the trash and not paying them. **Christian Tresize will send an email to Chairman Metcalf for use with Council Member LaCava**.
