## Suspect Arrested and Victim Identified in Shooting Death of Male in San Ysidro

On January 22, 2024, at approximately 4:07 AM, the San Diego Police Communications Center received a report of a shooting in the 100 block of East Calle Primera in San Ysidro. Officers from Southern Division responded quickly and located two victims suffering from gunshot wounds near a motel. Another involved victim was located near a gas station and the I-5 freeway a short distance away. All three victims were transported by Paramedics to local hospitals for treatment.

Unfortunately, the first victim was pronounced deceased at the hospital from multiple gunshot wounds to his upper torso. That victim was identified as Jorge Sahagun Osuna of San Diego. He is described as a 37-year-old Hispanic male. The second victim is described as a 31-year-old Hispanic male. He suffered multiple gunshot wounds but is expected to survive. He has been identified, but his identity will not be released at this time. The third victim is described as a 20-year-old Hispanic male. He suffered from one gunshot wound to his lower torso but is expected to survive. He has been identified, but his identity will not be released at this time. San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and have continued to investigate this incident over the past several days. Based on the preliminary investigation, it appears the suspect and victims all knew each other from living in the area. Detectives believe there was some sort of argument or confrontation that led up to the shooting, although details are not yet clear. The vehicle used in this incident has since been recovered. During the course of their investigation, Detectives identified Jose Antonio Granados Jr. of San Diego as the suspect in this case.

On January 25, 2024, at approximately 1:00 a.m., Granados was taken into custody during a traffic stop in the 3700 block of Camino Del Rio West. He is described as a 30-year-old Hispanic male. He was subsequently booked into San Diego County Jail for one count of Murder.
