

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:**

**Towne Centre Drive Pipeline Work Continues Between Excalibur Way and Renaissance Avenue for the Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels Project**

Jan. 5, 2024

Construction will now continue southbound on Towne Centre Drive and pipeline installation between Excalibur Way and Renaissance Avenue is set to start. Work is scheduled to occur during the daytime, Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and occasionally on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This schedule is contingent on unforeseen circumstances like inclement weather.

**What to Expect for Vista La Jolla Residents:**

- The Towne Centre Drive and Excalibur Way intersection will remain a four-way-stop while construction is occurring in front of the Vista La Jolla entrance/exit.
- Work in front of the Vista La Jolla driveways will be sequenced one at a time; i.e., both driveways will not be closed at the same time. The buildings will be notified prior to work impacting Vista La Jolla property driveway.
- Parts of Excalibur Way will see “no parking” signs during construction to allow easier flow of traffic.
- While work is occurring, flaggers will be in place to direct traffic in and out of the unimpacted driveway.
- After the end of the shift and outside of daytime work hours, residents will be able to access both driveways as steel plates will be installed to allow cars to drive over the pipeline trench.

**What to Expect:**

- There will be one lane in each direction in the Towne Centre Drive northbound lanes. The southbound lanes will continue to be closed for pipeline construction.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signage.
- Traffic control will accommodate access and the turning radius required for emergency vehicles.
