STAFF REPORTS

Francisco Peralta D9 reported the following:

SDPD Community Relations Officer Joshua Cummings reported the following: Has been driving through the area of 52nd and Orange Ave monitoring parking in the area and tow vehicles for suspended registration and 72 hour parking violations.

Colina Del Sol Pool Report:

Christopher McElroy- Construction on Colina Del Sol pool has started 2 weeks ago. Pool is projected to open spring 2024. They will be creating more swim lesson for the schools and public.

Area Manager, Dave Lee reported the following:

1. Colina – Home Depot Associates didn't come through. However, we have partnered up with Hands on San Diego and have scheduled a cleanup on Dec 2nd including the Colina Pool. 100 Yards of fiber for the playground was installed earlier this month. We are working with the neighboring schools to bring back the "Safe Passageway Home."
2. Rolando Park Elementary – Afterschool Program meet with Olivia the principal to get a program started. The employee we selected turned down the position so back to square one on that one. The next round of interviews will be conducted in the new year.
3. Clay Park – Booster Pump was fixed and reinstalled. Wiring to the clock was reconnected. New Clock was installed as well. We had numerous valves not responding to the clock. We had to turn off the water due to the homeless getting into the valves and flooding the park. The GDP was approved for Clay at the Park and Rec board meeting with the recommendation of having the placement of the comfort station restroom does not have an open gap between the back of it and the fence to the joint

use field. Also inquire about the possibility to use SD Unified School District property in the front area to create a larger area for the DOLA.

4. Tubman – Turf was stressing due to kids or park users shutting off the booster pump switch in the off position. Staff has fabricated it to lock the handle.
