

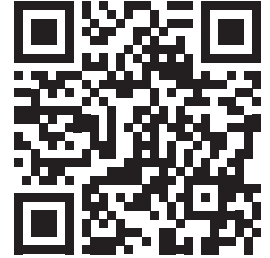
Virtual Recovery Assistance Center
