With respect to the section: "Neighborhood Revitalization and the LGBTQ Community 1970-1990"

The description as written makes no reference within the proposed boundary to the initial location of the LGBTQ Center in Hillcrest after its relocation from Golden Hill. The Center located immediately south of the Brass Rail on Fifth Avenue was declared historic as The Center/Gayzette/Albert Bell Building and its site should be included along with the location also to the immediate south on Fifth Avenue which was the location of David's Place Coffee House 3766 Fifth Avenue. Also not included in the written description and which should be referenced is the location of the S a n Diego Aids Project on Fourth Avenue just south of Robinson. Limited internet does not permit me to research the address.

The boundary map should extend further south of Robinson along Fifth to include the former sites of the Center and David's Place Coffeehouse.

The written description should also be revised to describe this core area as significant with the sites that served as focal points of the LGBTQ community social and political activism during the early years of the AIDS epidemic.
