

RESOLUTION No. 8168

RESOLVED, By the Common Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That certain ordinance passed by this Common Council on the 20th day of March, 1911, and entitled, "An Ordinance Authorizing the Lease of Forty (40) Acres of Land to be Prospected for Petroleum," and approved on the 20th day of March, 1911, is hereby submitted to the electors of the city for ratification by said electors, at the general municipal election, to be held in said city on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in April, 1911, being the 4th day of said month. Said ordinance so submitted as aforesaid, is in the words and figures following:

ORDINANCE No. 4404

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEASE OF FORTY (40) ACRES OF LAND TO BE PROSPECTED FOR PETROLEUM.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Common Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Common Council is hereby authorized to select and lease, not exceeding Forty (40) acres of the city's Pueblo Lands, lying north of the north line of the San Diego river, and containing, or supposed to contain petroleum, at such price as may seem to it to be just; such lands to be prospected for petroleum.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect on the thirty-first day from and after its passage and approval."

Said ordinance shall be stated in the ballot at said election in substance as follows:

For an Ordinance Authorizing the Lease of Forty (40) Acres of Land to be Prospected for Petroleum.

Against an Ordinance Authorizing the Lease of Forty (40) Acres of Land to be Prospected for Petroleum.

And every vote for said proposition as above stated shall be counted as a vote ratifying said ordinance; and any and every vote against said proposition as above stated shall be counted as a vote against the ratification of said ordinance.

Passed and adopted by the said Common Council of the said City of San Diego, California, this 20th day of March, 1911, by the following vote, to-wit:
